HEARING ORDER

The Vermont Transportation Board on May 10, 2017 beginning at 12:30 p.m. will conduct a site visit and evidentiary hearing on a petition by the Washington County Railroad Company to permanently close a Private/Farm Crossing that connects property owned by Stephen & Blandina Rojeck and John Roback & Gail Langoloh along Kendall Station Road in Norwich, VT to Vermont Route 5.


At the hearing, the Board also will consider a petition filed by John Roback to reopen the crossing, which was temporarily closed by the Railroad.
